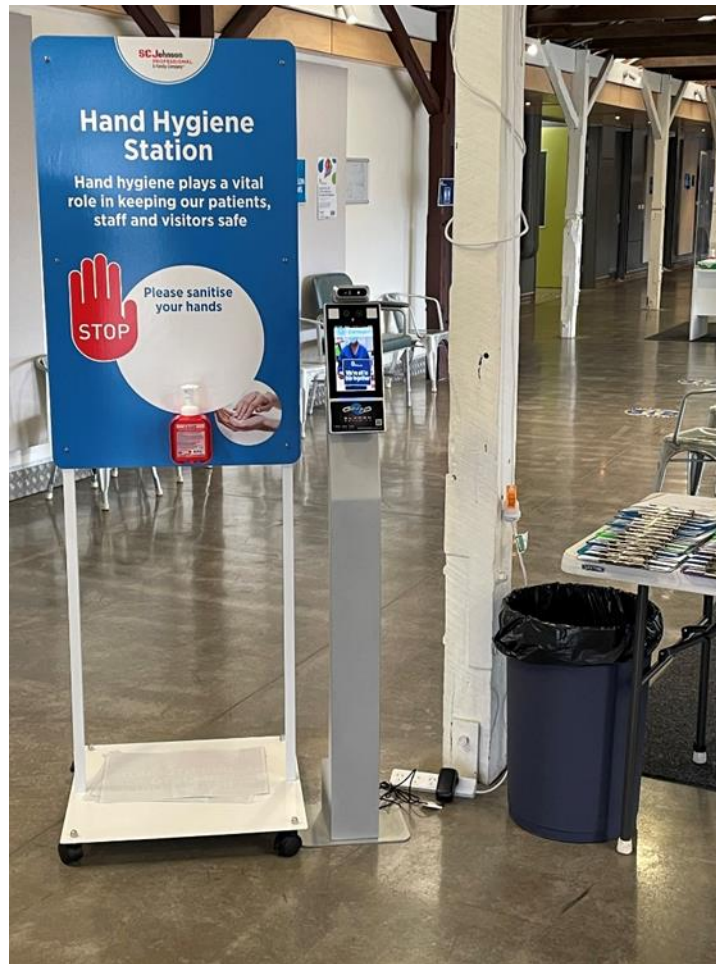

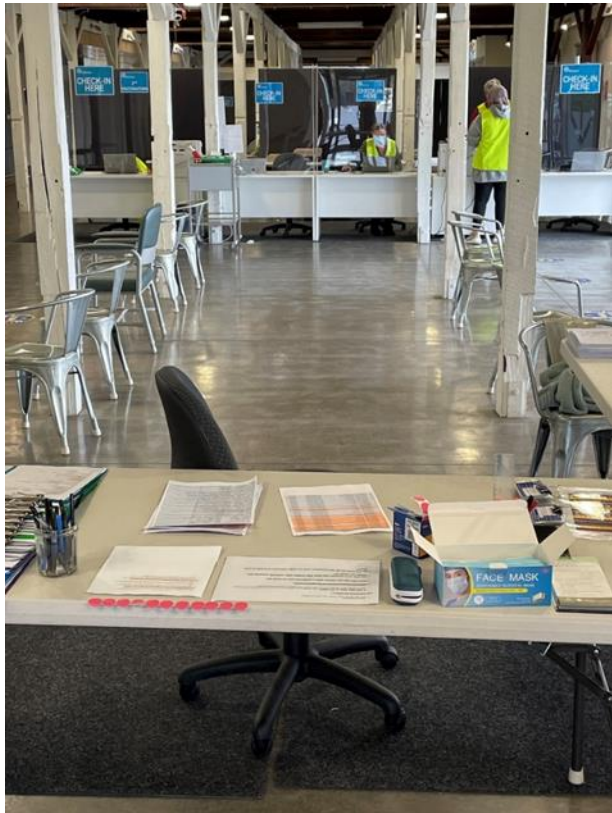

I will go to the desk. The person will ask me to fill in a form. A carer or family member can help with this. I will need my green Medicare card.



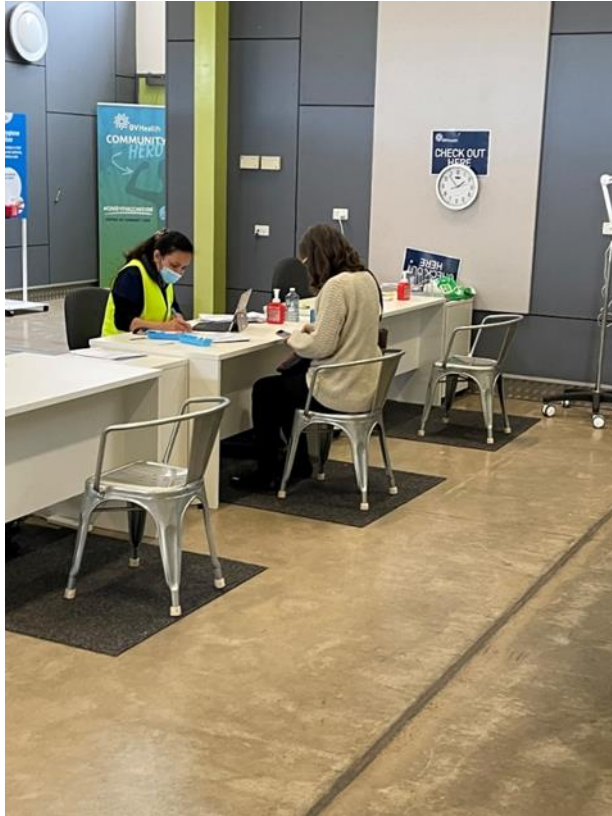

When my name is called, I go into a little room. I can have someone else with me. A nurse will ask my name and when my birthday is. The nurse will ask me if I understand about the COVID19 vaccine. It's OK to feel scared. The nurse will talk to me if I am worried and answer my questions.



The nurse will roll up my sleeve and clean my arm. The nurse will give me the vaccine using a needle. It may feel like a pinch. The nurse will put a Band-Aid on my arm.



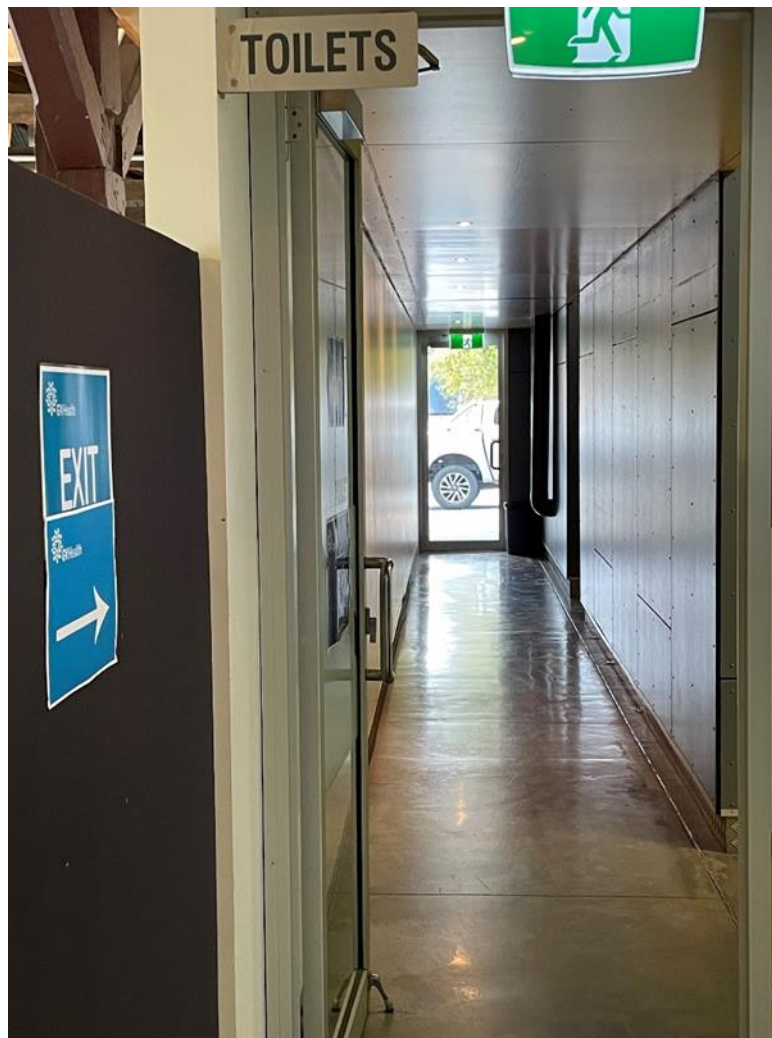
Then I will go to another waiting area where I will get a sticker. I will need to wait for 15 minutes.
