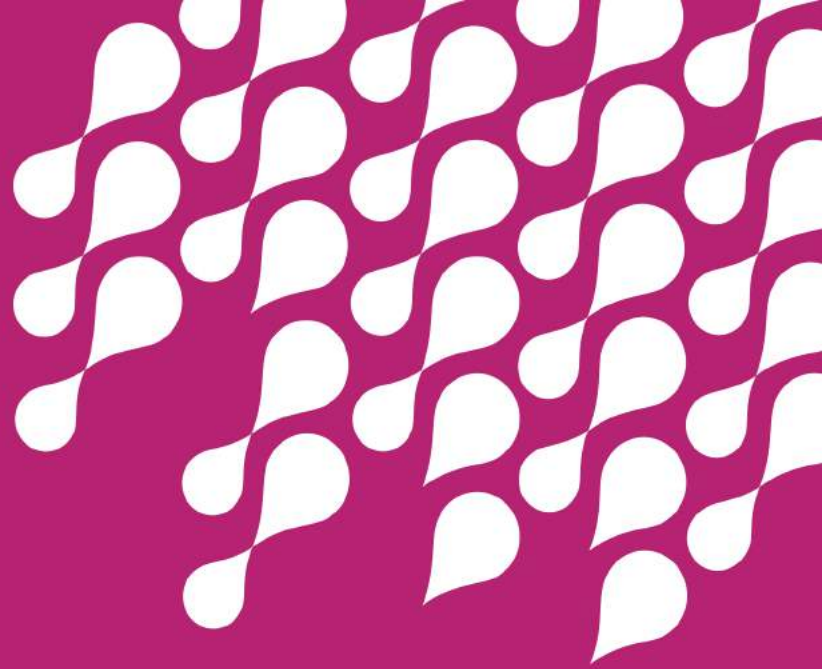

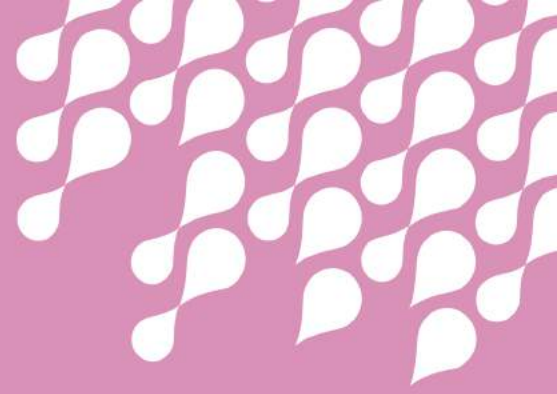

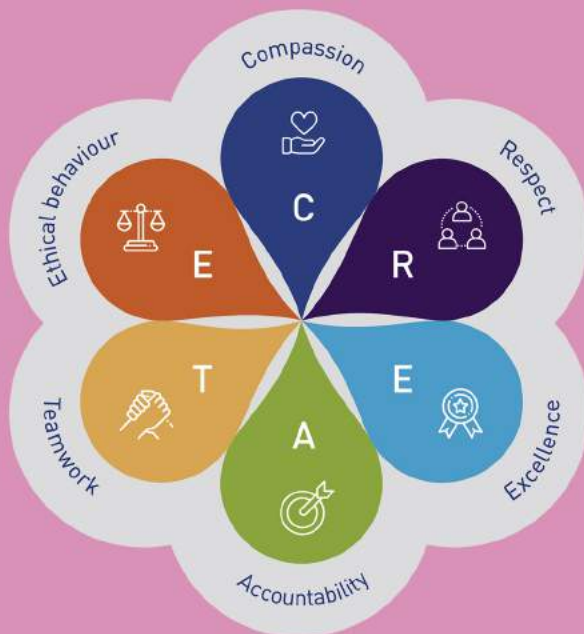


GV Health

Our services include a 24-hour Emergency Department, Surgery, Medical Services, Women's and Children's Services, Special Care Nursery, Rehabilitation and Palliative Care, Mental Health, Outpatients, aged care services at both Tatura and Rushworth, and community-based health programs.

GV Health is also the referral hospital for other Midwifery Units within the Eastern Hume Region, which provides a wide variety of exposure and experience to both low and high risk pregnancies.

- Regular debriefing with clinical educator



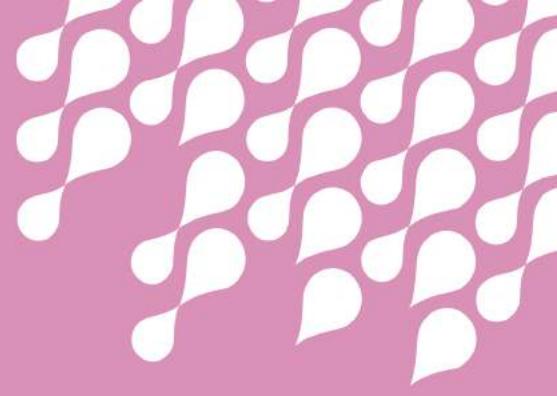
Support is provided by Midwifery Educators, Clinical Midwife Specialists, Senior Staff as well as support from the Obstetric Team.

- Cover letter
- Curriculum Vitae (*including details of the 3 most recent clinical placements*)
- Details of 2 clinical referees (*this comes through the PMCV website to all health organisations*)
- Academic transcript (*including a key*)
- Two most recent clinical placement appraisals including summative page
- A passport photo
