- Rotations through all areas of Maternity including Birth Suite, Postnatal, Domiciliary, Antenatal Clinic, Special Care Nursery, Breastfeeding Support Services as well as some of our outreach services
- Regular debriefing with clinical educator

Please ensure you meet the PMCV criteria. You must list GV Health within your candidate priority list.

Post graduate applicants should submit a direct application via **gvhealth.org.au**

Please include a cover letter, your Curriculum Vitae (including details of your three most recent clinical placements), two clinical referees, your academic transcript, your two most recent clinical placement appraisals (including summative page) and a passport photo.
