At Goulburn Valley Health Mental Health Service (GVAMHS) our aim is to offer a program of excellence, that aims to develop outstanding mental health nurses for the future. The service operates in a recovery-orientated framework to deliver high quality services to a diverse population.

We are looking for people who meet GV Health's organisational goals and have a passion for making a difference in mental health recovery. Applicants should have an interest in working with people with mental health issues, their families, carers and communities across the lifespan, to provide mental health care that supports and empowers.

In the Graduate Nurse Mental Health Program there are three clinical placements across a year. All graduate nurses rotate into the inpatient unit and are offered a range of experiences in our community teams and specialised residential care.



GVAMHS works in partnership with LaTrobe University to deliver a high quality program that offers transition into mental health nursing while exploring the most current theories and concepts underpinning mental health nursing.

On successful completion of the Graduate Nurse Mental Health Program, nurses will have completed approximately 50% of a post graduate diploma in mental health nursing and will have a range of career pathways available to choose from.
