Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts are to be submitted no later than June 16 2023
- All submissions are to be submitted to humealliedhealthconference2023@gmail.com
- There is no limit to the number of abstracts you can submit, however you cannot present more than two abstracts
- There is no fee for submitting an abstract
- No full papers are required
- The submitting author should be the presenting author, as the submitting author will be the designated contact person and will receive the relevant correspondence
- Oral and poster presenting authors are required to register as a delegate and pay to attend the Conference
- Appropriate approvals must have been obtained (e.g. ethics or organisational)

Abstract Format

All submissions must be emailed as an attached Word (.doc, .docx) document, adhering to the following:

- A cover page must be submitted with:
 - Contact details and brief biography of the submitting author (50 words)
 - Title, first name, surname, affiliation and email address for any co-authors
 - Abstract title
 - Requested presentation type - oral or poster
- A second page with the abstract must be submitted with:
 - Abstract title
 - Abstract - 300 words maximum. Submissions over this will not be accepted
 - Please use font size 11 and font type Calibri (Body)
 - Text only, i.e. without references, diagrams, tables, illustrations or graphics
 - No reference to the author names and organisations on this page due to the blind-review process
 - For all submissions, we recommend the following format: Introduction/Background, Methods, Results, Conclusion
- If preferred, there is a template on the website

The Selection Process

All abstracts submitted will be blind-reviewed by a panel consisting of members of the Conference Scientific Committee. Acceptance of an abstract will be based on relative merit and the degree to which the abstract meets the aims of the program. The criterion for evaluating abstracts includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Relevance to the Conference theme and sub-themes
- Importance of the presentation
- Relevance of content to audience
- Generation of innovative practice
