You will also be asked to provide your PMCV Candidate ID number when submitting your application to us. This is our way of quickly identifying that you are eligible for the Intern Computer Match. If you do not provide a PMCV Candidate ID number it will assumed that you are not eligible and your application will not proceed through the short listing process.

Assessments/References

All candidates must submit two on-line assessments/references via the PMCV Computer Matching Service. No additional references are required by GV Health. It is preferred that both references are obtained from Consultants, but if a Registrar is used please ensure these are from different disciplines.

Guidelines for Cover Letter

Your cover letter should be no longer than one page and address the following question: Why should GV Health select you as one of our interns? This is your opportunity to tell us about yourself.

Please note: There are no right or wrong answers. A cover letter is merely an opportunity for you to tell us a little more about yourself. It is common practice in any application process. Please address your cover letter to Mrs Carla Jewell, Manager Medical Workforce Unit.

Offers

All offers are made subject to the applicant successfully completing all requirements of their medical degree in 2024 and being eligible for provisional registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency

(AHPRA) in 2025. This includes English language requirements being met for temporary resident candidates successfully matched to GV Health.

Applications will open on *Monday 6 May, 2024* close *Thursday 6 June 2024.* There will be no extensions.

PLEASE NOTE: Under the rules of participation in the Victorian Computer Match, candidates will be unable to accept any position in Victoria other than the position to which they have been matched if they decline a matched position.

Commencement

Compulsory Intern Orientation will be held in Monday 6 January 2025. Intern positions commence the following week commencing Monday 13 January 2025.
