POSITION SUMMARY

The Acute Clinical Lead Physiotherapist is responsible for the coordination of efficient and effective physiotherapy services in the acute inpatient setting. They will work in partnership with senior clinical staff including medical and nursing leaders to ensure an integrated and coordinated person-centred focus of clinical care. The position will include a clinical caseload and an interprofessional approach to allied health referrals and service delivery across the acute inpatient clinical areas.

The Acute Clinical Lead Physiotherapist will:

- Be responsible for the planning and coordination of integrated physiotherapy services in the acute inpatient setting
- Provide clinical leadership to the physiotherapy team in this setting, to ensure the delivery of high-quality services
- Ensure physiotherapy facilitates efficient patient flow
- Embed an inter-professional, team-based approach across all allied health disciplines to ensure coordination of excellent, person-centred services
- Oversee the referral triage process, appropriate pathways and practice guidelines for our service to ensure timely care

They will also assist in the facilitation and coordination of Physiotherapy Student placements within the Physiotherapy Department and assist with the supervision of more junior Physiotherapists and Allied Health Assistants in their work areas as indicated, as well as supporting staff competency training.

The Acute Clinical Lead Physiotherapist reports directly to the Physiotherapy Manager and works closely with other senior clinicians in our department to provide leadership, management and quality improvement in the acute physiotherapy space and wider Physiotherapy Department at GV Health. Our team consists of Physiotherapists, Exercise Physiologists and Allied Health Assistants and delivers comprehensive services to the emergency, acute & subacute settings, as well as to outpatient and community patients. Our services are patient-focused, efficient and effective, consistently meeting established standards of excellence.

This position amongst others is responsible for promoting GV Health as a quality regional health service provider.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

The following duties are inclusive of but not limited to

- Provision of high-level physiotherapy services including assessment, treatment and management of patients, maintaining an independent case load, within the acute setting
- Coordinate and lead activity and deliverables in the acute inpatient setting, including resourcing of staff to meet service needs
- Actively participate in organisational projects, and regional and state-wide initiatives and ensure alignment with organisational priorities
- Ensure physiotherapy performance in the acute inpatient setting achieves service targets through regular monitoring
- Ensure physiotherapy staff deliver interventions that are contemporary, evidence-based and patient-centred
- Promote positive and effective learning experiences through the identification of staff education and development needs to ensure an effective acute allied health workforce
- Monitor and facilitate development of competency and capability training programs for physiotherapy and Allied Health Assistant staff
- Assist in the coordination of placements for Physiotherapy Students and liaise with tertiary institutes and the relevant student placement coordinators as required
- Communicate regularly with the Physiotherapy Manager to identify any departmental issues and gaps in service, thereby ensuring optimal department performance
- Work effectively with other senior clinicians and the Physiotherapy Manager to ensure that physiotherapy services meet organisational goals including optimising patient flow, facilitating safe discharge, and ensuring quality patient outcomes
- Attend relevant huddles, Daily Operating System (DOS), ward rounds and handover meetings to represent the physiotherapy perspectives in patient care and discharge planning.
- Oversee physiotherapy input of acute patients to optimise continuity of care and flow for patients as they transfer through the hospital during their admission
- Monitor and ensure appropriate allocations of therapists and Allied Health Assistants to meet caseload demands. Reallocate resources as needed, particularly in the absence of team members.
- Participation in physiotherapy weekend and public holiday roster as required
- Provide a high-quality service to internal customers and consumers that reflects best practice and adds value to GV Health
- Demonstrate appropriate clinical skills and capabilities at a grade 3 level
- Other duties as directed by the Physiotherapy Manager, for the efficient and effective running of the service

KEY SELECTION CRITERIA

Formal Qualification(s) and Required Registration(s):

- Relevant tertiary qualification in Physiotherapy
- Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency as a Physiotherapist

Essential:

- Extensive clinical experience and highly developed clinical reasoning skills, and/or expert knowledge regarding evidence-based physiotherapy interventions in the acute inpatient setting
- Sound experience and skills in leadership of teams at a program or service level
- Sound understanding of physiotherapy models of care across the inpatient settings including the prioritisation of patients based on clinical need
- Demonstrated understanding of patient flow and discharge planning including transition of patients through the healthcare system
- Demonstrated ability to evaluate clinical outcomes and practice based on evidence and research
- Highly developed interpersonal skills and a proven ability to effectively manage and negotiate innovative solutions to complex problems
- Experience and understanding of the clinical supervision process, and upskilling and mentoring processes for physiotherapists
- Sound communication and influencing skills within an inter-professional team environment, with an ability to engage key stakeholders and maintain effective professional relationships across organisational groups.
- Experience in working with, and giving direction to AHA staff to meet prioritisation guidelines.
- Excellent organisational skills and understanding of efficient time management.

Desirable:

- Minimum 5 years relevant acute clinical experience working as a physiotherapist
- Relevant post-graduate qualification in relevant area of speciality and/or management (or working towards same)
- Previous experience supervising junior physiotherapy staff and/or students on placement
- Previous experience in service evaluation and/or redesign, process improvement and change management
- Current Australian Physiotherapy Association (APA) membership
- Proficiency in a language other than English

 - Attendance and active participation at meetings as required
 - Acute and weekend staff attend competency training as required to ensure they are working safely and within their scope of practice
 - Evaluate acute inpatient physiotherapy service provision to identify any gaps within the service and actively generate education programs or service delivery reform to close gaps
 - Physiotherapy referrals are managed in a manner that facilitates optimal patient flow and timely discharge in line with organisational needs
 - Deliver prompt and effective physiotherapy services, ensuring patients receive timely care, including appropriate discharge or referrals.
 - Ensure efficient daily resourcing of AHA staff to meet clinical and departmental guidelines
 - Enhance engagement with medical & nursing teams and improve understanding on the role of physiotherapist in the management of typical acute presentations
 - Regular positive participation in a clinical supervision program as supervisor and supervisee
 - Submit required data and statistics in a timely manner
 - Adhere to the Australian Physiotherapy Council Code of conduct
 - Maintain compliance with core competencies and training requirements

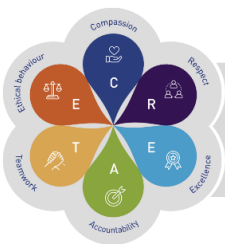
