POSITION SUMMARY

The Grade 2 Physiotherapist will be responsible for delivering physiotherapy services to the critical care unit (CCU), respiratory and medical units, but will work as part of the wider acute physiotherapy team with additional responsibilities on the surgical units, paediatric and maternity wards, and the emergency department if required.

They will function as a member of the wider multidisciplinary team and contribute to the delivery of high-quality physiotherapy services across the inpatient areas. Our team consists of physiotherapists, exercise physiologists and allied health assistants, and deliver comprehensive services across these settings. They will assist the clinical supervision and education of Grade 1 Physiotherapists, Allied Health Assistants and students in their work areas. Additionally, the physiotherapist will support staff competency training as required, particularly related to cardiorespiratory training.

The Grade 2 Physiotherapist will liaise with the ICU, medical and respiratory teams in particular, and oversee the role of physiotherapy as part of the multi-disciplinary team to ensure delivery of timely care and optimal patient flow, as well as participating in projects in line with department and organisational priorities.

The Grade 2 Physiotherapist will report directly to the Physiotherapy Manager and work closely with the Acute Clinical Lead Physiotherapist to provide leadership, management and quality improvement in the acute physiotherapy space at GV Health. The physiotherapist will apply evidence-based practice whilst employing effective methods of patient management, communication and information sharing with other services and health professionals.

Our services are patient-focused, efficient and effective, consistently meeting established standards of excellence. This position amongst others is responsible for promoting GV Health as a quality regional health service provider.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

The following duties are inclusive of but not limited to

- Provision of high-level physiotherapy services including assessment, treatment and management of patients, maintaining an independent case load, within allocated acute setting
- Work effectively with the Grade 3 Physiotherapist in their clinical area(s) and the Physiotherapy Manager to ensure that physiotherapy services meet organisational goals including optimising patient flow, facilitating safe discharge, and ensuring quality patient outcomes
- Attend relevant huddles, Daily Operating System (DOS), ward rounds and handover meetings to represent the physiotherapy perspectives in patient care and discharge planning.
- Oversee physiotherapy input of the respiratory and critical care units to optimise continuity of care and flow for patients as they transfer through the hospital during their admission
- Participate in clinical supervision, education and upskilling of grade 1 physiotherapists, physiotherapy students and Allied Health Assistants.
- Monitor and ensure appropriate allocations of therapists and Allied Health Assistants to meet caseload demands. Reallocate resources as needed, particularly in the absence of team members.
- Participation in physiotherapy weekend and public holiday roster as required
- Provide a high-quality service to internal customers and consumers that reflects best practice and adds value to GV Health
- Demonstrate appropriate clinical skills and capabilities at a grade 2 level
- Other duties as directed by the Physiotherapy Manager, for the efficient and effective running of the service.

Formal Qualification(s) and Required Registration(s):

- Relevant tertiary qualification in Physiotherapy
- Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency as a Physiotherapist

Essential:

- Minimum 2 years relevant acute inpatient experience working as a Physiotherapist.
- Highly developed clinical reasoning skills and understanding in patient physiotherapy management, particularly in acute settings
- Sound understanding of physiotherapy models of care across the inpatient setting including the prioritisation of patients based on clinical need and patient flow requirements.
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively within an interdisciplinary team environment, including the ability to create and maintain effective professional relationships across organisational groups.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills including an ability to liaise with a wide range of internal and external providers at all levels.
- Experience in working with, and giving direction to AHA staff to meet prioritisation guidelines.
- Understanding of the clinical supervision process and supervision of students on placement.
- Excellent organisational skills and understanding of efficient time management
- Experience in participation in quality improvement and research activities (or knowledge of process)

Desirable:

- Experience in the assessment, treatment and management of critical care, post-operative and respiratory patients
- Previous experience supervising junior physiotherapy staff and/or students on placement

- Current Australian Physiotherapy Association (APA) membership
 - Proficiency in a language other than English
