POSITION SUMMARY

This position provides expert professional knowledge to ensure the optimal use of medications within Goulburn Valley Health (GVH). The provision of clinical pharmacy and operational support services on a rotational basis across GVH campuses and contracted health partners to contribute to an adequate patient flow within the organisation and partnered Health Services

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

The following duties are inclusive of but not limited to the following:

- Deliver high-quality, patient-centred clinical pharmacy services consistent with SHPA standards and GV Health policies.
- Undertake clinical reviews, interventions, and medication reconciliations to ensure safe, effective, and evidence-based use of medicines.
- Provide ward-based clinical services, including participation in multidisciplinary ward rounds and patient care planning.
- Conduct patient counselling and education to optimise understanding, adherence, and therapeutic outcomes.
- Facilitate continuity of care through accurate discharge planning, timely supply of medications, and effective communication with primary care and community providers.
- Contribute to effective patient flow by prioritising discharge facilitation and medication-related discharge processes.
- Dispense medications for inpatients, outpatients, and discharged patients in accordance with legislative, professional, and institutional requirements.
- Manage the supply of non-impresit items, restricted substances, and aseptic or non-aseptic

- preparations in compliance with Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) and pharmacy protocols.
- Support maintaining appropriate stock levels, assist with ordering, and participate in annual stocktake processes.
- Ensure the safe, efficient, and accurate distribution of medications across GV Health campuses and contracted health partners.
- Provide accurate, evidence-based responses to drug information queries from health professionals and consumers.
- Support implementation and adherence to the GVH formulary, antimicrobial stewardship, and medication policy initiatives.
- Contribute to quality-improvement activities to promote rational, cost-effective, and safe medication use.
- Maintain up-to-date clinical knowledge and competency in line with AdPha Standards of Practice and the Pharmacy Board of Australia requirements.
- Participate in the GV Health Education Framework, including mandatory training, competency assessments, and continuing professional development activities.
- Engage in the Performance and Development (PD) review process and actively seek feedback for professional growth.
- Comply with all GV Health policies, procedures, and legislative obligations governing pharmacy practice.
- Provide clinical and operational pharmacy services on a rotational basis across GV Health campuses and contracted health services.
- Participate in rostered shifts, including weekends, late shifts, public holidays, on-call, and relief duties as required.
- Support departmental operations, including workflow management, quality assurance, and continuous service improvement activities.
- Undertake other duties as directed by the Deputy Director of Pharmacy or delegated supervisor to support service delivery and departmental objectives.
- Work collaboratively within multidisciplinary teams to ensure coordinated, patient-focused care.
- Liaise with internal and external healthcare providers to promote seamless transitions of care.
- Participate in ward and departmental meetings, case discussions, and clinical governance activities related to medication management and safety.
- Contribute to the promotion of the pharmacy service as an integral component of GV Health's clinical care model.
